

CHIEF JUDGE ORDER 2004-3

OF A USEFUL PUBLIC SERVICE PROVIDER) ORDER
IN THE FOURTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT)

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. 18-1.3-507 A probation department, sentencing court, county sheriff, board of county commissioners, or any other government entity, or a private nonprofit entity which has a contract with a government entity, may establish a community or useful public service program; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners for El Paso County on 11-1-04 has approved Front Range Community Service as the useful public service provider of El Paso County.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- a. Front Range Community Service shall be the sole useful public service provider for El Paso County.
- b. Front Range Community Service shall be said sole service provider for adults and juveniles sentenced as adults in El Paso County Courts.
- c. No self-placements or any placements outside of Front Range Community Service will be recognized by the Courts.
- d. This Order shall apply to all sentences ordered after December 10, 2004.
